OTHER TUITION COVERS

Tuition fee covers tuition, basic medical supplies and medications for fever and colds, administration costs, library computer use with limited printing, day parking, notes and handouts, tutoring (when necessary), industry presentations, international invigilation (examiner) fees and career advice. Any unused services, supplies, benefits, etc. included in the tuition fees are non refundable.

TUITION FEE DOES NOT COVER

Book & damage deposit, health & accident insurance, special school meal events, medical examination fees, optional City & Guilds examinations, examination retakes, TESDA FEES, other ICAAC fees indicated in the ICAAC General Information Booklet, personal expenses including travel to and from the school and the internship site, pocket money.

METHOD OF PAYMENTS

Payments hy Chenue or Rank Transfer are to be made to either the following account name.

² Tuition fee is inclusive of One (1) set Resturant Service Uniform, Class & Workshop Ingredients, Meals during Restaurant Operations and City & Guilds Advanced Diploma Written Examinations & City & Guilds Certificate in Food & Beverage Service written & practical assessment. PAYMENT SCHEDULES

- Upon enrolment: 40% of total tuition fees + Php12,000 (Book & Damage Deposit) + Php1,400 (Medical Exam Fee & School ID)
- Second payment: 30% of total tuition fees, every last week of February & July of each school year/semester
- Final payment: 30% of total tuition fees, every third (3rd) week of April & September of each school year/semester

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Payment deadlines for City & Guilds Examination Registrations are every third Saturday of April or September of each year. Payment deadlines may change to an earlier date depending on City & Guilds Examination Registration deadline. If the candidate is unable to make payments upon the due dates, their student status may be suspended and are not allowed to join their classes or continue with their programmes.

If candidate is unable to make full payment on last payment due date, candidate may not be registered for the International City & Guilds Examination and late charges are applicable for any late exam registration in the amount of £200Gbp. **ICAAC reserves the right to increase course price and other fees without prior notice.**

BOOK & DAMAGE DEPOSIT

A refundable deposit of Php12,000 is required to cover any damage caused to ICAAC property by the student during their studies. It is payable upon enrolment and is refundable 15 working days after all school clearance has been submitted. Any books issued to the students that they wish to keep at the end of the semester will be deducted from this deposit. Other miscellaneous fees such as Health & Accident Insurance, Special School Meals, Excursions, Graduation Photo Shoot, etc. will also be deducted from the deposit.
